TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

The venue will be instituting a Traffic Management Plan (TMP) for these concerts. The TMP is designed to protect access for local residents and businesses and assist the safe and efficient flow of patrons arriving and departing the Stadium by public transport. Visit the website for more info.

BUMP IN / OUT

Bump in will run between 7am and 7pm. Some after hours work may occur during bump out. Works being undertaken at night will be contained within the Stadium. When works take place throughout the night, staff will be deployed externally to monitor noise levels.

Through-traffic in Castlemaine Street during bump-in times will not be affected however, some parking spaces on the eastern side of the street could be used during these times.

CHIPPENDALL STREET

During the bump-in period through to the completion of the concert. Chippendall Street will be unavailable for local parking apart from those allocated special parking permits by Christ Church Milton.

Truck parking will be contained to Chippendall Street, and drivers are instructed to turn off engines while stationary.

Note: Traffic Control Officers will be present during bump-in and bump-out to monitor and control traffic and ensure safety.

PARKING RESTRICTIONS & ROAD CLOSURES

Parking restrictions within the Lang Park Traffic Area will commence from approximately 1 hour before gates on the day of the concerts and apply until 11.30pm those nights. All major road and lane closures are shown on the map.

Traffic signs will be erected in the relevant streets and barricades will be placed and manned in these areas to enforce the restrictions. Offending vehicles will receive onthe-spot fines or be towed away if required.

Local residents and business traffic requiring access to these areas on event days just need to inform security staff or Police that they intend on visiting a residence or business in the area. However, visitors need to remember the 15 minute on-street parking restrictions apply unless otherwise signed.

NOISE MANAGEMENT

Suncorp Stadium engage specialist noise consultants to assist in the management of noise control measures for the concert and rehearsals.

A team of sound engineers will be onsite for all sound checks and rehearsals. Sound engineers will be at the sound control panel and will be in communication with technicians monitoring noise levels at locations outside the Stadium to ensure levels remain compliant with noise guidelines.

SOUND SYSTEM CHECKING & TESTS

Testing of the sound system will be conducted leading up to the concert. Times are yet to be confirmed but they will only occur between 10am and 8pm and will not exceed three hours in duration on any day. The times will be posted on the Stadium website www.suncorpstadium.com.au and social media platforms when confirmed.
