Mandatory Requirements

Contingencies are to be implemented for operating in winds. Nominate the wind speed at which the Fireworks will be cancelled.

☐

All Pyrotechnics must be securely fixed to prevent accidental movement. Associated wiring must be run in a safe manner and secured to prevent persons tripping over the cable or dislodging the pyrotechnics.

☐

Provide details of the facilities available to monitor speed and how this will be communicated to the Stadium.

☐

Have you provided all current licenses for the technicians & QLD Fireworks Contractor Licence to the Stadium Representative.

☐

If Close Proximity Pyrotechnic projectiles rise greater than 122 metres (400 ft) above ground level, then clearance from the Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) is required.

☐

Have you provided the stadium with the Risk Assessment including Firefighting process, SWMS, JSA, any approvals required, list of total net explosive on site, Gas compliance certificates, SDS, insurances, inductions are complete.

☐

Outdoor Multishots or shells are not permitted at Suncorp Stadium.

☐

There must be sufficient fire extinguishers to cover multiple incidents, the extinguishers must be placed in proximity for easy access.

☐

RSHQ approval and notification has been received and sent to the Stadium prior to the event.

☐

Certificate of insurance not less than twenty million is required.

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| ☐ Prior to the start of the event the Pyro technics technician is to meet with relevant stakeholders, Reliance Risk, Alpha one Security, Grounds and where applicable the rider of Buck the Horse. | ☐ If rooftop or gantry access is required, the relevant permit must be completed, and keys and radio obtained from security. |
| ☐ Check with security if any fire service isolations are required. | ☐ A map of the flame or pyrotechnics set up must be provided to the stadium prior to the event. |
| ☐ A map showing precise location of the effects. Risk Assessment, SWMS, RSHQ acknowledgement, Net explosive quantity summary, JSA, notification to QFD, Suncorp Stadium Checklist Crew list, SDS for product, Roof or gantry permit if required. Casa notification if the display is above 122 metres (400ft) | ☐ Ensure the fire extinguishers been inspected prior to the event? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. They are the correct kind of extinguisher (water and/or CO₂). b. Are unused and are full. c. In test and have an attached tag in accordance with AS2444-2001. Include sand if it is required for firefighting processes. |

T SHIRT LAUNCHER

- ☐ Have the users been trained to use the launcher including any special guests.
- ☐ What distance will the launcher reach?
- ☐ The Launcher is not to remain unattended.
- ☐ You must provide the SDS for the launcher propellant
- ☐ You must provide a Risk assessment and SWMS for the use of the launcher to the Stadium and ensure everyone is trained including special guests.
- ☐ What wind speed would cease the operation of the flames.

FLAMES

- ☐ Have you notified the stadium of the exclusion zone.
- ☐ Have you provided a map of the flame locations.
- ☐ At what speed would the flames not go ahead?
- ☐ Have you provided the SDS for the LPG?
- ☐ Risk assessment and SWMS provided.

SPARKULAR MACHINES

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| ☐ Confirm the crew are all trained in the use of the Sparkular machine. | ☐ Has a Risk Assessment (RA), SWMS, SDS been provided, and the RA includes the storage location of additional powder? |
| ☐ Can you confirm that all staff all trained in firefighting procedures with the machine and that is sand available. | ☐ Stadium QLD require confirmation that all powder cleaning of the machines must be completed in BOH areas only. |



PYROTECHNICS CHECKLIST

**All documentation on the pyrotechnics checklist must be received by the stadium 5 days prior to the Event.
The crew are responsible for cleanup and all rubbish must be removed by the contractor.
If pyrotechnics are fired from the roof a photo should be forwarded to assets after cleaning up.**
