Mandatory Requirements

All persons conducting a business, or an undertaking (PCBUs) and workers must comply with Workplace Health and Safety (WHS) legislation and follow safe work practices to ensure, so far as reasonably practicable, the health and safety of all

The display must not vary from that approved and described unless the Chief Warden has been advised. This may occur if changes must be made due to wind speed or direction

Only Close Proximity fireworks as approved in the Queensland Code OF Practice can be used.

The setting, wiring and detonation of approved pyrotechnics must be carried out only by the person(s) authorised by the QLD Government, they must hold a current Fireworks Operator Licence approved by RSHQ. The authorised person must hold a QLD government approved Explosives Security Licence.

At least two suitably trained attendants, each equipped with a 5kg CO2 fire extinguisher, must stand by immediately prior to and during the detonation of pyrotechnics ready to take appropriate action to prevent damage or injury.

The remote-control pyrotechnics firing equipment must not be accessible to the public and once set should not be left unattended.

All Pyrotechnics must be securely fixed to prevent accidental movement. Associated wiring must be run in a safe manner and secured to prevent persons tripping over the cable or dislodging the pyrotechnics.

Protection is required for all floor surfaces e.g. FOP, carpet, and stage pieces that come into direct contact with pyrotechnics residue.

At all times the licensed pyrotechnician has the right to give reasonable directions to any member of event staff or security in order to maintain a safe working environment.

Pyrotechnics must be positioned in such a manner that the licensed pyrotechnician can visually check the safety conditions from the firing position immediately prior to the firing. If the licensed pyrotechnician cannot see the pyrotechnics from the firing position, then there has to be an observer who is also a licensed pyrotechnician who is able to relay any updates

Firing point must not be less than 250 metres from a dangerous goods store including LPG storage.

Close proximity fireworks differ from other fireworks because they are intentionally designed for use before approximate audience. Until recently, close proximity displays were almost exclusively conducted indoors, but now also include the use of specially produced pyrotechnics in stadium events such as those used during major sporting matches and entertainment performances.

Prior to the start of the event the Pyro technics technician is to meet with relevant stakeholders, Reliance Risk, Alpha one Security, Grounds and where applicable the rider of Buck the Horse.

A map showing precise location of the effects. Risk Assessment, SWMS, RSHQ acknowledgement, Net explosive quantity summary, JSA, notification to QFD, Suncorp Stadium Checklist Crew list, SDS for product, Roof or gantry permit if required. Casa notification if the display is above 122 metres (400ft), Please include a copy of any Alternate Safety & Security Measure that is required if applicable.

Have fire service isolations been requested through security

Certificate of insurance not less than 20 million is required.

All documentation on the pyrotechnics checklist must be received by the stadium 7 days prior to the Event.
